Music and Media Ministry: Pastor Bryan Warren

With this growth and the accomplishment of our 2013-2015 Vision Goals we have a need for a full-time assistant. A brief description of this position is as follows:

7. Media

- (1) Remodel the dome lobby to accommodate our guests and guest service needs. This would house a permanent location for our Spanish ministry, an identifiable information center, improved bookstore area, and flat panel televisions for video announcements and other information.
- (2) We would like to expand our products with items such as artwork and gift items. Lighted bookshelves would be added to highlight books and materials from ministries around the world.
- (3) Increase signage in lobby for directions to different areas of our campus to accommodate guests in our facility.

Next Level and Ground Zero Student Ministry: Pastor Donnie Lewis

Vision Statement: We exist to create an atmosphere for young people to experience the presence of God, to disciple them in the things of the Lord, and commission them to impact their world around them.

Core values: Excellence, Integrity, Family, Relationship, Purpose

Next Level:

1. Intern Team

- a. Adding new intern team members and giving them more opportunities to minister, lead and reach their goals and to assist us in meeting the goals of Next Level.
- b. Turning servant evangelism over to our intern team and the students of Next Level, with the supervision of a few key adult leaders.

2. Discipleship

- a. Strengthen our intensive discipleship program (Level Up groups) for those students who have a desire to go even deeper into the things of God.

3. Worship

- a. Adding students to our team who have a passion for worship and the move of God.
- b. Continuing to create an atmosphere to allow our students to experience the power of God through worship and in turn learn how to worship God on their own.
- c. Having quarterly "NOW" – Night of Worship, times for our youth to encounter God on a different level.

4. Missions Ministry

- a. Giving our kids the opportunity to go outside the walls of our church by participating in mission trips – both domestic and international.
- b. Continue to train and mobilize our students to reach their school campus as missionaries.

5. Missions Giving

- a. Putting a greater emphasis on missions and giving. We want to increase our contributions to Speed the Light (\$7500 goal in 2013) and stir up faith in our young people to sacrificially give. We also will be allowing opportunity to give to our GWOC missionaries (Africa Team) on a regular basis.

6. Wednesday Night Services

- a. Being even more relevant in the message while not compromising the Gospel.
- b. Creating a service that makes our students want to invite their friends.
 - (1) Keeping our facilities clean, fresh and current with the youth culture
 - (2) Allowing our students to have a say in the order of services as well as more student participation in the services.
 - (3) Hold quarterly "Excite Nite" services that are theme based and evangelical in nature to make it "easy" for our students to invite their friends to church.

5. Prayer

- a. A stronger focus on prayer and intercession. We will continue to recruit students with a heart of intercession to our Wednesday night intercession service. We will be placing a higher level of accountability to our students to participate in our pre-service prayer each week.

6. Follow up

- a. Expanding our follow up procedures. Keeping track of our newcomers (guests) and getting them plugged into our home groups.

7. Home groups

- a. Expanding our number of home groups, currently we have 5 active groups. This is a vital backbone ministry of Next Level, which allows our leadership and influence to be multiplied.

Ground Zero:

We will continue to keep Ground Zero (our jr. High Ministry) relative to the 6th through 8th grade student. This will be a service time mixed with high energy activity, intense praise and worship and a mix of relative talk and small group meeting. We meet on the first and third Sundays of each month.

3-D Children's Ministry: Pastor James Markham

3-D children's ministry will provide an atmosphere that the children will enjoy the gospel and become full followers of Jesus. It is our goal to bring Christ to each child no matter where they are spiritually while presenting Him in a language and method they understand. We know that each child is unique and that is why we have various ministries which are geared to meet them at their own level of spiritual development. 3d Children Ministry will always be dependent upon divine direction and the empowerment of the Holy Spirit. It should be God-focused, grounded in Scripture and under girded in prayer. We will remain mindful of the fact that effective ministry of any sort will be opposed by the Enemy and will need to be fought. Ministry to children should involve parents and include an intentional scope and sequence focusing on cultivating spiritual formation and transformation such that this generation is able to effectively pass on a vibrant, compelling faith to the next.

1. We will have several days where children can invite their friends and neighbor during the year. We will have the a Birthday Party Celebration Day, Birthday Party for Jesus, Harvest Day, Sweet Tart Day, Easter Celebration Service day, Super Hero Day, Character Day, Color Days, and many other days for children to reach out to their friends.
2. In summer months we will hold a Kids Crusade (if funding is provided) instead of Vacation Bible School. This innovative endeavor will give an opportunity for the kids to invite their friends and family to come to church.
3. We will strive in our services to teach leadership roles to teens and young adults that will help our volunteers become faithful workers, lay volunteers, and ministry leaders in the future.

4. We also train kids and young teens in Evangelism, music, drama, object lessons, memory verse games, and Puppetry. This will help them learn how to impact their generation for Jesus. We will provide fund-raisers and events for the Puppet Team to participate in Fine Arts and Puppetry Competitions'. We will coordinate, practice, facilitate, and train this group of teen-agers.
5. In October we will have a family outreach that will help bring in families to our church. This activity will be on October 31 and have facets that will appeal to the entire family unit. (The size of the event is dependent on evangelism funding).
6. We will utilize the check-in system data base for information/statistics on regular church attendance, visitor frequencies, and additional information. We will also utilize data base to develop email mailings and newsletter outreaches.
7. We will continue to facilitate the Nursery in new procedures, development of procedural handbook, training of volunteers, and completion of theme rooms and decorations.
8. We will continue to seek new and innovative ideas through internet research, magazines, and trainings such as Children's Pastors Conference in Orlando.
9. We will coordinate and facilitate a Children's Missions program that trains children on how to give to Missions and pray for Missionaries. We would also like to share this vision with the adult congregation and have their partnership in this endeavor.
10. We will facilitate and coordinate Kids' Kamp that enables children to have a spiritual encounter week. After this event, we will share in testimonies what God has done in the children's lives. We will also coordinate and facilitate 'The Heart of Adriene' snack shop to raise funds for children to go to camp.
11. We will coordinate and facilitate a Easter Egg Hunt (size is dependent on funding) for the community to reach families and kids with this outreach.
12. We will coordinate and facilitate Nursery, Rangers, and Impact Girls' programs with award ceremonies, crownings, trainings, ministering at Girls' Sleepover, and any other needs these programs present.

Spanish Ministry: Pastor Victoria Jones

Our Ministry works hand in hand with Pastor David Garcia's vision for Grace World Outreach Church and according to the will of God for the Spanish Community in our Church. Nothing is done in this Ministry that is not submitted first to God and then to our authority Pastor Garcia. For this reason, I submit what the Holy Spirit has put in my heart as a purpose and goals for the Spanish Congregation.

1. Casa de Gracia is and continues to be a House of Prayer (Matthew 21:13), where healings and miracles take place as the presence of God increases in our Services.
2. To preach the Word in a loving but truthful way as it is needed.
3. In the year of 2012 we grew 30%. We expect to grow in the next three years the same percentage every year, reaching the amount of 120 attendees at the end of 2015.
4. **Missions.** We have been focusing on Missions and we continue helping in every way we can any time there is a need for a Missionary or Evangelist. We will continue helping Missions in Cuba, Mexico and Africa with offerings and supplies. Our vision for 2014 is to go to Cuba and help the Evangelist Julio Torna in one of his trips.
5. **Evangelism.** Every month we plan to go on the streets to reach the Latin Community in this area.
6. We have a group of 12-16 children every Sunday and we will continue giving them Bible Classes every Sunday during the Service. Our expectation for these three years is to grow in number.

7. To continue with the Grace Group that has had a great impact on the families attending it. We meet the third Friday of every month.
8. Give special importance to the translation of Pastor Garcia's preaching every Sunday morning in the second service using the Bulletin to advertise it, as many people don't know we have this help. We have the capacity for 20 ear phones and we hope they all will be used in the future. This will enhance the Service as many people want to come in the morning but don't understand English.
9. To have a Marriage Retreat every year as we know we are living in a time and moment where the couples need to be strengthened and encouraged.
10. To sponsor one or two of our youth to go to the Youth Retreat every year.
11. **Mentoring.** I am mentoring 6 ladies from the Spanish Congregation for their spiritual growth and training them to be Mentors later on.

Ministerio en Español: Pastor Victoria Jones

Nuestro Ministerio trabaja mano a mano con la visión del Pastor David García para Grace World Outreach Church y de acuerdo a la voluntad de Dios para la comunidad Hispana en nuestra Iglesia. Nada se hace en este Ministerio sin que se someta primero a Dios y luego a nuestra autoridad Pastor David García. Por esta razón, someto lo que el Espíritu Santo ha puesto en mi corazón como propósito y metas para la Congregación en Español.

1. Casa de Gracia es y continuará siendo una Casa de Oración (Mateo 21:13), donde ocurren milagros y sanidades mientras continúa aumentando la Presencia de Dios en nuestros servicios.
2. Predicar la Palabra en amor pero con la verdad como debe ser predicada.
3. En 2012 crecimos un 30%. Esperamos crecer en los próximos tres años el mismo porcentaje cada año, llegando a tener 120 asistentes.
4. **Misiones.** Nos hemos enfocado en Misiones y continuaremos ayudando en la forma en que podamos cada vez que haya una necesidad en un Misionero o Evangelista. Continuaremos ayudando a misiones en Cuba, Méjico y Africa con ofrendas y provisiones. Nuestra meta para 2014 es ir a Cuba y ayudar al Evangelista Julio Torna en uno de sus viajes.
5. **Evangelismo.** Cada mes planeamos ir a las calles y alcanzar más personas de la comunidad Latina en esta área.
6. Tenemos un grupo de 12-16 niños cada domingo y continuaremos enseñándoles la Biblia en una clase especial para ellos. Nuestra meta para estos próximos tres años es crecer en número.
7. Continuar con el Grace Group que ha tenido gran impacto en las familias que asisten a él. Nos reunimos el tercer viernes de cada mes.
8. Dar especial importancia a la traducción de la prédica de Pastor García cada domingo, en el segundo servicio, anunciándola en el Boletín, pues mucha gente no sabe que tenemos esta ayuda. Tenemos capacidad para 20 audífonos y esperamos usarlos todos en el futuro. Esto es importante pues muchas personas que no entienden Inglés quieren venir a la Iglesia en la mañana.
9. Tener un Encuentro Matrimonial cada año pues sabemos que estamos viviendo un tiempo donde las parejas de matrimonio necesitan ser fortalecidas y recibir aliento.
10. Patrocinar uno o dos jóvenes par air a los retiros de jóvenes cada año.
11. **Tutoría.** Estoy instruyendo seis damas de la Congregación en Español en su crecimiento espiritual y entrenándolas para que ellas puedan ser Tutores después.
